Opening Times

Mary MacKillop Museum is open: Tuesday - Sunday, 10am to 4pm

Closed: Mondays, Good Friday and between Christmas and New Year

Museum Admission

Students \$5 (Year 5 upwards: Museum is not suitable for younger children)

Teachers - Free

Accompanying Adults - Free

Time

Upper Primary students: 90-120 minutes. Secondary students may appreciate a longer time.

Prior to the Visit

It is essential that teachers work with Museum personnel to prepare for the visit. A site visit is recommended so that teachers can lead their students' Museum experience.

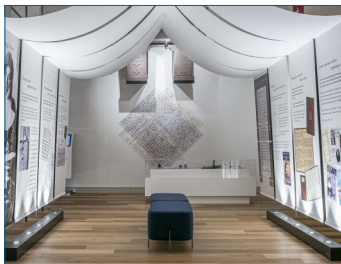
During the Visit

- The group will be given an introductory talk by Museum personnel.
- Students will be given the opportunity to experience the interactive, 'hands-on' and audio features of the Museum.
- Some groups may wish to book Bethany Centre for a half or full day retreat.
- The group may wish to spend some quiet time in St Joseph's Chapel where Mary MacKillop prayed often.

Facilities and Access

Mary MacKillop Precinct makes every effort to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all visitors.

- School bags must be stored in lockers. Please check in at Admissions Desk. The Museum takes all care but accepts no responsibility for belongings left in the lockers.
- Toilets are located in both the Museum and Bethany
- There is wheelchair access to all areas of Mary MacKillop Precinct and there are designated disabled toilets.
- Guide dogs are welcome. Dog bowls are available.
