Opening Times

Mary MacKillop Museum is open: Tuesday - Sunday, 10am to 4pm
Closed: Mondays, Good Friday and between Christmas and New Year (until 2nd week of January)

Time

We recommend that you allow between 60-90 minutes for the visit. The length of your visit can, of course, be arranged to suit the group's needs.

Prior to the Visit

It is essential contact Museum personnel to prepare for the visit.

During the Visit

- Individuals are free to make their own way around the museum. A map is provided for all visitors. Alternatively, a guided tour can be pre-arranged
- The group may wish to spend some quiet time in St Joseph's Chapel where Mary MacKillop prayed often
- Some groups may wish to book Bethany Centre for a half or full day retreat. Separate charges apply for the use of Bethany
- The Museum Gift Shop will open to browse.

Facilities and Access

Mary MacKillop Precinct makes every effort to provide a safe and comfortable environment for all visitors.

- Large bags and back packs must be stored in lockers. Please check in at Admissions Desk. The Museum takes all care but accepts no responsibility for belongings left in the lockers. We recommend that you carry your valuables with you when visiting the Museum.
- Toilets, baby change table, gift shop and emergency exits are clearly marked on the Museum map. If you need any other assistance during your visit, please ask our volunteers.
- A Museum Café will be opened in 2020.
- There is wheelchair/gopher access to all areas of the Precinct and there are designated disabled toilets.
- Guide dogs are welcome. Dog bowls are available for them.

Photography

Photography is permitted in the Museum, Chapel and outside in the grounds of Mary MacKillop Precinct. However, flash photography is **not** permitted.
